Dear CIN Provider/Practice Manager:

The United States Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General (OIG) has oversight of compliance programs for entities such as hospitals, accountable care organizations, and clinically integrated networks (CIN) that participate in Medicare Advantage or Medicaid managed care programs. The OIG mandates that entities have a compliance program which includes a compliance plan, compliance education, auditing and monitoring, as well as a standards of conduct.

Specifically, our CIN compliance plan requires annual compliance education and distribution of the standards of conduct to CIN providers. Enclosed is the CIN compliance education as well as the CommonSpirit Health Standards of Conduct Our Values in Action (SOC) for distribution to each CIN provider for review. As new providers are on-boarded in the CIN practice, each provider should receive the CIN compliance education and SOC for review.

Please track education completion and receipt of the SOC by all providers.
